Lodging (bed linens provided), breakfast, and dinner are included, as well as, van transportation to/from ski areas, lift tickets, and lessons. Campers should bring towels, personal items and money for lunch.

Ski campers without skis or snowboards can be outfitted with skis, poles and boots or snowboard and boots for a rental fee of \$100.00.

Winona Ski Camps are limited to 20 campers, allowing for flexibility in deciding evening programs. This also gives the campers the opportunity to participate in the decision making.
