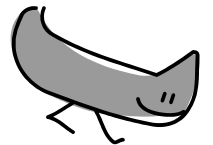


GREETINGS & SALUTATIONS FROM THE JUNIOR SHORES OF MOOSE POND ONE LAST TIME!

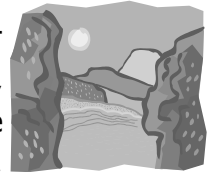
